
Please park in in the Oakland Avenue Parking Deck

GPS address: 900 Oakland Avenue or 711 Kenilworth Street, Greensboro, NC. The deck is visible from Spring Garden Street behind Yum Yum Ice Cream and Old Town pub.

Handicap accessible parking is available inside the deck and in nearby surface parking lots.

Bicycle parking is available throughout campus. Covered bike racks and a repair station are located on the east side of Oakland Deck via Forest Street. A limited amount of indoor bike parking is available in the School of Education, ground level via Kenilworth Street.

After parking, please walk to the <u>Bryan 160 Auditorium</u> to check in at the NC Bike Summit registration table.



UNCG OAKLAND AVENUE PARKING DECK

GPS address: 900 Oakland Avenue or 711 Kenilworth Street, Greensboro, North Carolina

From the North and East (Burlington, Raleigh/Durham, Richmond, VA):

Take I-40 West to Exit 218B and turn right onto Freeman Mill Road. At the first traffic light, turn left on Coliseum Blvd and follow for approximately 1.5 miles. At the third traffic light, turn right on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

From the South (Salisbury, Charlotte, Atlanta, GA):

I-85 North to Exit 120-A toward Greensboro. Continue 2.2 miles and take Exit 35-B to Hwy 220 North / I-40. Turn left on Coliseum Blvd and follow for approximately 1.5 miles. At the third traffic light, turn right on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

From the West (Winston-Salem, Asheville, Knoxville, TN):

I-40 East toward Greensboro. Bear right near Exit 212A to continue on I-40. Take Exit 214B to Wendover Ave East, turning right and continuing for approximately 3.5 miles. Turn right on Market Street and continue for approximately 1 mile. Turn right on Aycock Street South. Continue past Walker Avenue, then turn left on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

From the North on Highway 220 (Eden, Martinsville, Roanoke, VA):

Highway 220 South becomes Battleground Ave. Stay on Battleground until you cross Cornwallis, then bear right on Westover Terrace. (Battleground Ave and Highway 220 will bear left.) As you cross Benjamin Pkwy, Westover becomes Aycock. Continue past Walker Ave, then turn left on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

From the South on Highway 220 (Asheboro, Rockingham):

From Highway 220 North, turn left on Coliseum Blvd and follow for approximately 1.5 miles. At the third traffic light, turn right on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

From the North on Highway 29 (Reidsville, Danville, VA):

From Highway 29 South take the Wendover Ave West / Hospital exit. Follow Wendover for 2.6 miles and take the Westover Terrace exit. Merge right, following the Coliseum sign. As you cross Benjamin Parkway, Westover becomes Aycock. Continue past Walker Avenue, then turn left on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

From the South on Highway 421 (Sanford, Fayetteville):

From Highway 421 North, take I-40 West toward Winston-Salem. Take the Freeman Mill Road / Coliseum Area Exit 218B. Turn left on Coliseum Blvd and follow for approximately 1.5 miles. At the third traffic light, turn right on Spring Garden. The parking deck is properly by the collection of the collect

From the Piedmont Triad International Airport

Exit the airport following signs toward Greensboro and Bryan Blvd. Continue approximately 8 miles. Turn right on Aycock Street. Continue past Walker Avenue, then turn left on Spring Garden Street. The parking deck is on the right, accessible from Kenilworth or Forest Street to Oakland Avenue.

At the deck entry gate, please press the entry button to pull an entry ticket.

After parking, please walk across Spring Garden Street to the Bryan 160 Auditorium to check in at the NC Bike Summit registration table.

When you are ready to leave, deck exit gates will raise automatically, one vehicle at a time. *If you need assistance, please use the intercom to communicate with a deck attendant.*
